

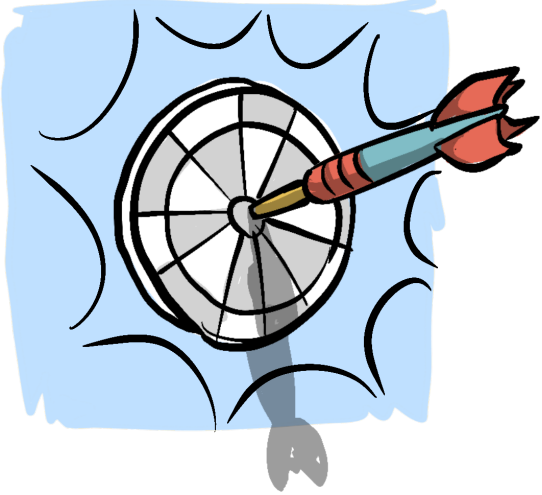

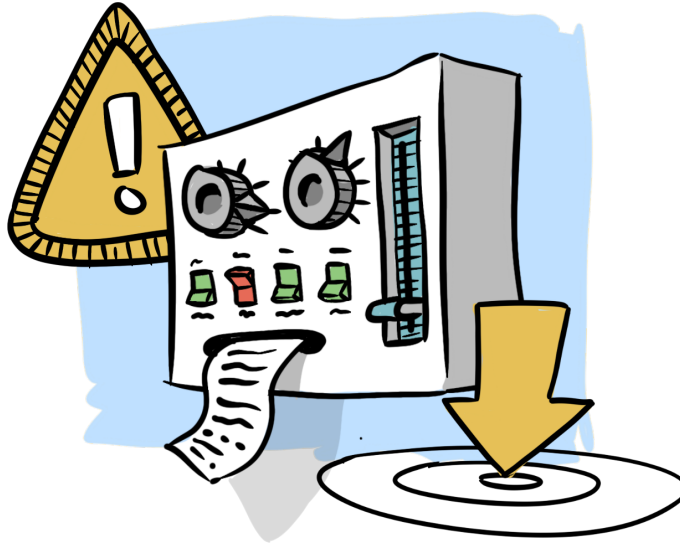
Ambitions in AR7



Action-oriented

Speak to stakeholders to find *policy relevant information* that informs action

- Policy *relevance* should **not** become *policy prescriptive*



Integration

Showcase jointly multiple aspects of climate: hazards, development, impacts, adaptation, mitigation

- This requires strong integration across Working Group domains



Inclusivity

Reflect the rich diversity of societies, and target multiple stakeholder audiences

- Multiple views and perspectives should be considered
